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<u>Report of IEBM for the period from 21st March 2018 to 26th Nov. 2019</u> for conducting 1st AGBM on 14th March 2020 at 2:00 pm in YWCA.

<u>Plot No. 6-7, Sector-10, Dwarka,</u> (Conference Hall No. 1, 1st Floor), New Delhi-110075.

Salient features of Aims & Objects of Memorandum of Association of IEBM are reproduced below for ready reference of IEBM members:-

Para 3 of MOA

- (a) To provide a platform for Ex-Bordermen, their widows and dependents for legal redressal of their service/pension related grievances which are affecting a cross section of Ex-Bordermen, a particular rank or a large group.
- (b) To identify the areas in which the Ex-Bordermen, their widows and / or dependents have been discriminated against vis a vis similarly placed personnel in uniform and strive to seek legal remedy.
- (c) To sensitise Ex-Bordermen, their widows and dependents about injustice meted out to them or neglect of their natural justice by the Union of India or any other agency, and apprise the Ex-Bordermen about their legitimate, legal and genuine rights based on principles of equivalence and also apprise them about the legal remedies.

2. Pursuant to above, IEBM has already filed following 5 WPs, the court hearings of which are in progress. The details of orders can be downloaded from Delhi High Court website. Benefits will be subject to court order and implementation:-

(a) WP(C) No. 3761/2019 of pre 10.10.97 retires of the ranks of Inspectors, SIs and Constables. <u>Date of 1st order 12.04.19</u>. Out of 3200 members of IEBM, list of beneficiaries Insp. 38, SIs-47 and Constables - 363 attached with the WP.

b) WP(C) No. 4310/2019 of 2^{nd} or 3^{rd} MACP of the ranks of SIs, ASIs and constables who retired between 01.01.2006 and 01.09.2008. <u>Date of 1^{st} order = 26.04.19</u>. List of ASIs-36, HCs = 109 and Constables - 56 attached with the WP.



c) WP(C) No. 4561 / 2019 of all ranks who retired on 30^{th} June 2006 or 2007 or 2008 and so on upto 2018 for benefit of one increment for retiral benefits. <u>Date of 1st order = 30.04.19</u>. List of 110 members of all ranks attached with the WP.

d) WP(C) No. 4942/2019 of pre 2006 retirees of the ranks of HCs and ASIs. <u>Date of 1^{st} order = 16.05.19</u>. Out of total 3200 members of IEBM, List of beneficiaries ASIs-27 and HCs-718 attached with the WP.

e) WP(C) No. 7447/2019 of 1^{st} or 2^{nd} ACP of the ranks of HCs and Constables who retired between 01.01.1996 and 09.08.1999. <u>Date of 1^{st} order = 12.07.19.</u> List of HCs-274 and Constables - 84 attached with the WP.

3. In addition to 5 WPs filed and in progress as stated above, 2 WPs of BSF Service Pay and OROP will be filed in DHC by the end of Jan 2020. All required data & grounds of arguments has been given to the advocate alongwith advance legal expenses and 1st draft of the WP of BSF Service Pay, submitted by the advocate is under scrutiny by IEBM core team.

4. Besides above, IEBM after due research and diligence has already decided to file following 6 WPs. For these 6 WPs advance legal expenses has been paid to the advocate and his team has started drafting of these WPs:-

(a) WP for digitisation of pension records of Ex-Bordermen to facilitate revision of pension of Ex-Bordermen. As on date, the pension of lot many pre 2006, post 2006 and post 2016 pensioners has not been revised inspite of follow up actions by Ex-Bordermen.

(b) WP for Ex-Servicemen status akin to Army by amendment of definition of ESM by DOP&T followed by reservation for appointments in Guard Duties akin to Army in Public Sector Banks, PSUs, Central & State Governments.

(c) WP for CSD facilities akin to extended to Ex-Servicmen with 50% exemption in GST.

(d) WP for medical cover facility to Ex-Bordermen by establishment of CPMF-CHS akin to ECHS.



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(e) WP for claiming arrears of Fixed Medical Allowance (FMA) pertaining to Ex-Bordermen pensioners who are not availing CGHS facilities.

(f) WP for extablishment of BSF Welfare Housing Organisation akin to Army Welfare Housing Organisation (AWHO) for housing needs of Ex-Bordermen on control rates akin to being alloted to Ex-Servicemen.

5. Following 3 WPs have been identified by IEBM after due diligence, research and consulting advocates. Out of these 3 WPs, WP for set up of Dedicated Division Bench (DB) of Delhi High Court for speedy disposal of CPMFs cases needs to be filed on priority:-

(a) WP for set up of a dedicated bench of DHC for expeditious disposal of pending cases of CPMFs in Delhi High Court.

(b) WP for improvement in MACP scheme from existing 3 upgradations after 10,20 and 30 years to 3 upgradations after 8, 12 and 24 years w.e.f. 01.01.2006 akin to given to Army personnel.

(c) WP for claiming share out of Armed Forces Flag Day Fund operated by Ministry of Defence for welfare and rehabilitation of Ex-Bordermen, their widows and children.
