NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. 287(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1986, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Amendment Rules, 1987.
- (2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1986.
2. In the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1986,—
 - (a) in sub-rule (2) of rule 2,—

clause (a) shall be omitted and clauses (b) to (i) shall be re-numbered as clauses (a) to (h) thereof;
 - (b) in rule 3,—
 - (i) in clause (3), after the words “scales of pay”, the words, “whether fixed or otherwise”, shall be inserted;
 - (ii) in clause (5), after the words “scale of pay”, the words, “whether fixed or otherwise”, shall be inserted;
 - (c) in rule 6, in sub-rule (1), for the words “any order made subsequent to that date, within three months of the date of such order”, the words “any amendment made to these rules, within three months of the date of publication of such amendment” shall be substituted;
 - (d) in rule 8,—
 - (i) for Note 1, the following Note shall be substituted, namely:—

“Note 1.—Wherever the pay has been fixed under these rules, the efficiency bar will become operative only with reference to such bars in the revised scale, irrespective of whether a Railway servant had crossed or not crossed or had been held up at the efficiency bar in the existing scale.”;
 - (ii) in Note 4, for the words and figures “Notes 2 and 3 above”, the words and figures “provisos 3 and 4 above” shall be substituted;
 - (e) in rule 11, in the Explanation, in clause (b), the following shall be inserted at the end, namely:—

“and in the case of posts included in these rules by the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Amendment Rules, 1987, means the period commencing on the 1st day of January, 1986, and ending with the 28th day of February, 1987”;
 - (f) in the First Schedule,—
 - (A) Against serial No. 19 in column 2 for the words “Private Secretary (Railway Board only)” the words “Private Secretary (Railway Board and RDSO only)” shall be substituted.
 - (B) after Serial No. 19 and the entries relating thereto, the following entries shall be inserted, namely:—

Reference Notification No.G.S.R.1099(E) dated 19-9-1986 forwarded with Railway Board's Endorsement No.PC-IV-86/RSRP/1 dated 19th September, 1986 on the above subject.

2. Schedule in two parts viz. Annexures 'A' and 'B' showing the revised scales of pay applicable to the various categories of Railway employees in Group 'D', 'C' and 'B' is enclosed. The revised scales take effect from 1st January, 1986. The schedule has the sanction of the President.


3.1 In terms of Rule 5 of the Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1986, notified vide G.S.R. No.1099(E) dated 19-9-1986, Railway servants are required to exercise their options in the format appended as Second Schedule to the rules. The sequence of action to be taken after receipt of option will be as follows:-

- (i) For those employees who give timely option to switch over to the revised scales of pay, pay may be fixed in the revised scale and salary for October, 1986 (or wage period of October) drawn and paid on the basis of revised pay after deduction of subscription to Provident Fund with reference to the revised pay.
- (ii) After salary for October, 1986 (or wage period of October) is drawn and paid in the revised scales, bills may be drawn separately for arrears of pay for the earlier period and paid after ensuring deduction of Provident Fund subscriptions on the revised pay. The arrears for the period 1.1.1986 to 31.3.1986 will have to be deposited in Provident Fund account.
- (iii) Similar sequential action as indicated above may be taken for employees whose options might be received later on.

3.2. The employees may also be requested to voluntarily opt for depositing the arrears of pay in their Provident Fund Accounts for the period from April, 1986 to September, 1986.

4. Every effort should be made to arrange payment of arrears with pre-check by the Accounts Office. However, such pre-check may be waived wherever absolutely unavoidable in consultation with your F.A. & C.A.O. Post-check will be done in all cases where pre-check is not conducted. The facility of making payment of the arrears without pre-check will not be admissible in the case of those who have quit service on account of retirement, resignation, etc. after the date of implementation of the revised pay scales but before drawal of arrears, as also in the case of employees whose death took place before exercising option for the drawal of pay in the revised pay scales.

5. The statement of fixation of pay (Specimen copy enclosed - Annexure 'C') should be prepared in triplicate one copy to be pasted in the service book of the Railway employee, the second copy to be left for office record and the third copy to be sent to the Accounts Officers concerned.






